Rules, Appeals, Protests and Discipline

- 1. **Rules All rules** not explicitly mentioned in the BSSAC meet information document will follow the World Athletics (WA) rules.
- 2. **Appeals** matters which develop during the conduct of an event must be orally appealed to the **Chief** of the event before the event is completed.
- 3. All **protests** must be in writing.
 - a. Protests relating to matters which develop during the conduct of the meet, must be made to the Referee or Competition Secretary and be filed at once, but in any case, not more than 30 minutes after the result has been announced and/or posted, whichever comes first.
 - b. Protests must be made to the Referee or Competition Secretary on the official protest form and with a \$50.00 cash deposit.
 - c. The referee, in consultation with the meet directors, shall consider any and all available evidence, including clear photographic and/or videotaped evidence, when reviewing protests.
 - d. A protester may appeal an unfavorable decision of the Referee to the Jury of Appeals. The decision of the Jury of Appeals is final. The cash deposit will be forfeited in all instances where a protest is accepted and denied. If the protest is upheld, the cash deposit shall be immediately refunded to the protester.
- **4. Discipline** The BSSAC Management Committee reserves the right to institute any additional disciplinary measures deemed necessary to an athlete, team or team official where there is a verbal or physical confrontation with another competitor, official or volunteer staff of the meet.
